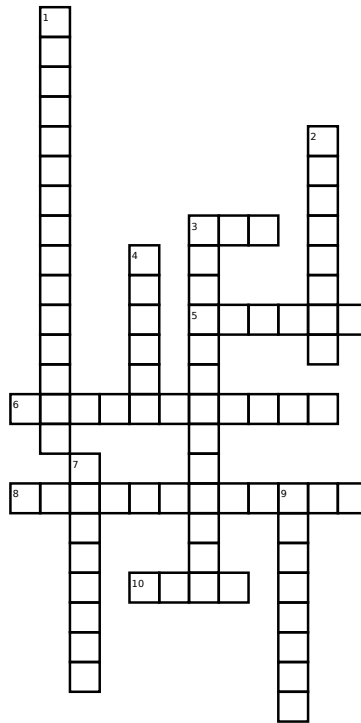


Archaeology Crossword Puzzle

Down:

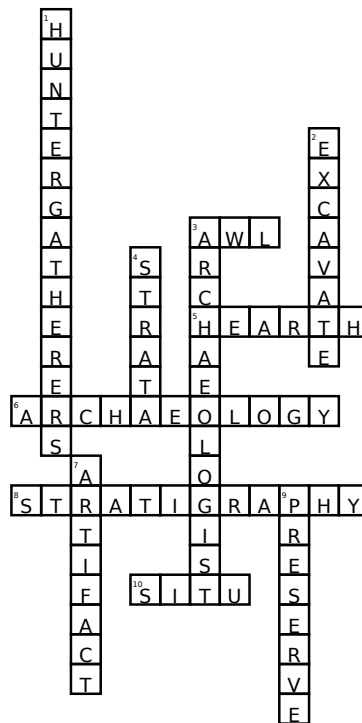
1. Ancient people who moved around constantly hunting animals and gathering plants.
